**Review Of Minutes:** Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes. Rodney seconded; motion carried.

**Review Of Bills:** Bradley made a motion to approve the bills. Rodney seconded; motion carried.

**Review of Agenda:** Bradley made a motion to have an executive session before the Old Business report, seconded by Rodney; motion carried.

**Public Comment:** There is a new small engine repair shop that is looking for local business called Paddy Mountain Outdoor Power. The township should look into using them. Joe Schnure. gave a business card for more information.

**Rec. Center Report:** Joe Snyder gave the report for the Rec. Center: Everything is going well at this time. We are very busy with rentals. We did pretty good at the Christkindl Market. The roof leaks, Rodney will be calling Equity to find a solution. Rodney and Joe ran the generator in December just to make sure everything works in case of an emergency. There was a suggestion that the township should have a stockpile of supplies in case of an emergency like bottled water, flashlights, etc. We will table this discussion once a better plan is thought out. Joe asked if they could place a pipe/post that is about 4ft tall as a door stop since there is nothing to stop the doors. Sometimes the wind catches them and

it's damaging the hinge that holds them in place. Kayla will check with insurance just to make sure it's okay with something there.

**Zoning Report:** Nothing to report.

**Road Master Report:** Rodney gave the Road Master report for the month of January: 1. The T-Tag is being fixed. 2. All the servicing is done as of now until we get more snow. 3. The spreader motor on the single axle is being replaced. 4. We are still looking for a newer T-Tag.

**Treasurer's Report:** 1. Kayla gave the treasures report: The state did perform an audit on December 18<sup>th</sup> for the year 2023 & 2024 for the State Account. Everything came out in good standing. Kayla is just waiting for a written report which may take some time to receive. Kayla is working on all tax things such as W-2's and annual reports.

An executive session was held. Discussion resolves appointing of committee members within Hartley Township.

**Old Business:** Bradley made a motion to appoint Harold Zimmerman for a 5-year term on the Sewer Authority Board. Rodney seconded; motion carried.

Rodney seconded; motion carried.
