Meeting March 11, 2026**

Call to Order

Pledge/ Prayer

Review Of Minutes: Bradley made a motion to approve the minutes. Barry seconded; motion carried.

Review Of Bills: Barry made a motion to approve the bills. Bradley seconded; motion carried.

Review of Agenda: Bradley made a motion to add solar energy systems, Rec. center leak, sewer pit & well, malfunctioning septic in Weikert & treasurers bond. Rodney seconded; motion carried.

Public Comment: 1.) Charles with Axtman Engineering was here to show blue prints for stormwater run off for the Zimmerman Layer house. After some discussion Bradley made a motion to approve the stormwater run off for the proposed layer house. Barry seconded; motion carried. 2.) Don Kauffman stated that his land lease with the township is up in April and would like to renew it. The land lease will be placed on the agenda in April. 3.) Bradley & Kayla mentioned about people calling the township with sewer related questions/ checks not being cashed. The supervisors suggested that Kayla call Bob Wagner since he is the president to see if he can resolve the issue.

Communication: Nothing to report.

West End Fire Company: Kayla read the report, the report as follows: 1 House Fire mutual aid-Mifflinburg, 1- Medical Assist and 2- MVA's.

West End Ambulance: Nothing to report.

Rec. Center Report: Joe Snyder gave the report for the Rec. Center: We are busy with rentals on the weekends and ball teams during the week. If there is a rental scheduled then the ball teams can't be in. The rentals always come first then the ball teams.

Zoning Report: Nothing to report.

Road Master Report: Rodney gave the Road Master report: 1. We plowed and cindered a total of 4 times since the last meeting. 2. Changed out can trailers at recycling. 3. Cut down a tree that was hanging out over Paddy Mountain Road. 4. Filled pit holes and cleaned out debris in ditch lines on Paddy Mountain Road. 5. Replaced the serpentine belt on the backhoe. 6. Filled pot holes on Shirk Road and Aikey Road. 7. Pushed a standing dead tree down on Hackenburg Road. 8. Fixed stop signs on Pollock, Shirk, Polly & Hackenburg Road. 9. Drained skating rink pond. Someone did leave their snowblower by the skating rink but we are unsure who it belongs to. 10. We did sign the contract with Penn State for the grant for Paddy Mountain Road for a total of \$82,500.00.

Treasurer's Report: Kayla gave the treasures report: We received the Liquid Fuels money for a total of \$82,968.54.

Old Business: 1.) Tomorrow we will be meeting with a well driller at the Rec. Center. Bradley does have three different well drilling companies to look at drilling the well for the rec. Center. Shaffer, Stackhouse & Zimmerman. 2.) Barry made a motion to up the treasurers bond to 1 million dollars. Bradley seconded; motion carried. 3.) Bradley did call Equity roofing but they did not return his call yet. Kayla will email them to see if we can get in contact with them to look at the leaking roof. 4.) Now that the weather has warmed up a little Rodney will be getting the Bollards for the Rec. Center. As well as getting 4-5 posts and putting a fence around the sewer pump pit. 5.) We have not heard anything about the malfunctioning septic in Weikert since our last meeting. 6.) After much discussion regarding the Emergency Management Director for Hartley Township. Bradley made a motion to advertise in the Union County Times for a volunteer that is a resident of Hartley Township to be the Emergency Management Director. Rodney seconded; motion carried. 7.)

Bradley made a motion to advertise the road bids and they will be opened on April 8th at our next meeting. Rodney seconded; motion carried.

New Business: The supervisors received a sample ordinance for large solar farms and data centers from the CKCOG. The supervisors discussed what negative/positive effects they both have on the environment and revenue they generate. Bradley made a motion to send the sample ordinances to the Planning Commission for review. Rodney second; motion passed.
